CERTIFICATION OF COMPLIANCE WITH OPEN MEETING LAW

The Health and Human Services Committee received an e-mail noting the agenda for the September 15, 2020 meeting of the Health and Human Services Committee was posted on September 11, 2020 at 12:10 p.m., in compliance with the Open Meeting Law.

REVIEW AND APPROVE MINUTES: September 1, 2020 Health and Human Services Committee Meeting

Vice Chair Brauer presented the minutes of September 1, 2020 for approval. Supervisor Goehring moved to approve the minutes and Ms. Kliejunas seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

ANNOUNCEMENTS AND CORRESPONDENCE

Health and Human Services Director Matt Strittmater did not have any announcements to share with the Committee today.

DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORT(S)

Health and Human Services Director Matt Strittmater presented to the Committee a picture of the Public Health grant-funded mask signage on Sheboygan buses via #maskupsheboygan. The Program Evaluation and Prioritization process will begin in October; Committee members are encouraged to begin reviewing materials and sending questions in advance. Chair Hoffmann would like the Committee's consideration and input into starting the meetings at a later time. Discussion ensued with Committee members agreeing to move future meeting's start time to 8:30 a.m.

DISCUSSION AND UPDATE ON COVID-19

Public Health Nurse Manager Starr Grossman provided an update on the County's response to Covid-19. Starr spoke about the County's benchmark criteria and areas of concern including testing availability, contact tracing, and hospitalizations. Starr indicated continued communications with area schools and close collaboration. Questions were answered and discussion ensued.

PRESENTATION ON CAREGIVER PROGRAMS AT THE ADRC - ADRC/Operations Manager Michelle Acevedo and Caregiver Coordinator Lisa Hurley

ADRC/Operations Manager Michelle Acevedo introduced Lisa Hurley, Caregiver Coordinator, to the Committee. Lisa talked about the services available to Sheboygan County residents including online workshops and resources to support caregivers. Questions were answered and discussion ensued.

PRESENTATION ON THE 2020 HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES BUDGET FORECAST UPDATE – Health and Human Services Director Matt Strittmater

Health and Human Services Director Matt Strittmater reviewed the 2020 budget forecast update with the Committee. Matt reviewed division budget forecasts vs. actual and what precipitated the variances including Covid-19 impacts. Projections early in 2020 were forecasting a significant negative variance. Hard work by Divisions and unexpected revenue have resulted in a current projection of coming in under budget for 2020.

CONSIDERATION OF 2020 BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS – Accounting Manager Mary Jablonski

Accounting Manager Mary Jablonski discussed the 2020 budget adjustments. Adjustments are being proposed to account for the change in current grants with a net increase in revenue. Ms. Kliejunas moved to approve the 2020 budget adjustments and Supervisor Montemayor seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

CONSIDERATION OF VACANT POSITION REQUEST – WOMEN, INFANT AND CHILDREN (WIC) NUTRITIONIST – Public Health Manager Starr Grossman

Starr Grossman presented to the Committee a Vacant Position Request – WIC Nutritionist. Discussion ensued and questions were answered. Supervisor Montemayor moved to approve the vacant position request for WIC Nutritionist and Supervisor Schobert seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

REVIEW AND APPROVE VOUCHERS

The vouchers for September 15, 2020 were reviewed by the Committee. Health and Human Services Voucher information provided to HHS Committee members will once again have additional detail on credit card purchases of significant or multiple items. Supervisor Goehring moved to approve the vouchers and Ms. Kliejunas seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. Questions were answered and discussion ensued.
