REVIEW AND APPROVE MINUTES: May 21, 2019 Health and Human Services Committee Meeting

Supervisor Brauer moved and Ms. Kliejunas seconded to approve the minutes of the May 21, 2019 Health and Human Services Committee. Motion carried unanimously.

Matt Strittmater noted that the Joint Finance Committee takes on Governor Evers' proposal this week, so details on the State's budget will be forthcoming. Two visitors from the public also introduced themselves: Diana Dombrowski, from the Sheboygan Press, and Kristin Kaat, a student.

UPDATE ON HEALTH & HUMAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT 2020 BUDGET PUBLIC HEARING

Matt Strittmater distributed flyers and offered an overview of the upcoming Health & Human Services Department's 2020 Budget Public Hearing. The hearing will take place at the Rocca Room at Mead Public Library on June 17, 2019 from 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. The public hearing will be split into two parts. The first section will include an overview of the budget process and allow for general public input. The second half of the session will include an overview of the Child Welfare system and a guided group discussion exercise. Matt also explained the outreach

process for the public hearing, involving placing ads in the paper, email blasts, and posting at local libraries.

SAVE A LOT GROCERY STORE CLOSURE IMPACT AND POTENTIAL OPTIONS

Supervisor Brulla offered an ongoing update to the Committee on the closure of the Save A Lot grocery store on 8th Street. She noted that she is working with alderperson Mary Lynne Donohue to create an online survey for neighborhood residents. This will help form a baseline of information that can inform future decisions and ideas. Chair Hoffman also shared that he had a decision on this topic with Mayor Vandersteen. The Mayor's Office expressed interest in redoing a previous neighborhood survey, which would also address this topic.

CONSIDERATION OF RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF A COMPREHNSIVE RESPONSE TO METHAMPHETAMINE AND OPIOID ADDICTION

Matt Strittmater introduced the resolution, indicating that it was referred to the Health & Human Services Committee by the County Board. He also noted responses from Adam Payne, Joel Urmanski, and the Polk County Administrator. Discussion on the local response to addiction and jail population ensued and questions were answered. The Committee decided to file the Resolution in Support of a Comprehensive Response to Methamphetamine and Opioid Addiction for information.

Behavioral Health Manager Jackie Moglowsky also offered the Committee an update on various Sheboygan County Health & Human Services programs related to opioid addiction, an AODA therapy and detention center collaboration, Drug Treatment Court, Intensive Outpatient Services, and detox services.

REVIEW AND APPROVE VOUCHERS

Supervisor Brauer moved and Supervisor Baumgart seconded to approve the Health and Human Services vouchers as presented. Motion carried unanimously.
