Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 59.11, the March 17, 2026 session of the Sheboygan County Board was called to order by Chairperson Keith Abler at 6:00 p.m. Chairperson Abler noted that the notice of meeting was posted on March 13, 2026 at 3:00 p.m. in compliance with the open meeting law.
