JOURNAL OF THE MEETING OF THE SHEBOYGAN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

March 19, 2024

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 59.11, the March 19, 2024 session of the Sheboygan County Board was called to order by Chairperson Vern Koch at 6:00 p.m. Chairperson Koch noted that the notice of meeting was posted on March 15, 2024 at 3:00 p.m. in compliance with the open meeting law. The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance by all present.

The roll call was taken and recorded with 23 Supervisors present; (2) Supervisors attended remotely: Supervisors Immel, and Jorgensen; Absent: 2, Supervisors Coulson, and Kulow.

Supervisor Brauer moved for approval of the February 20, 2024 Journal, which was distributed to all supervisors prior to the meeting. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Clarke and carried on unanimous roll call vote of the board.

LETTERS AND COMMUNICATIONS

The Clerk presented a resolution from the Barron County Board of Supervisors requesting changes to Wisconsin State Statutes, per diem payment authority for County Board members service on municipal library boards, and number of county board members to serve. COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

County Administrator Alayne Krause reported that the Departments annual reports have been completed. They will be posted on the Departments respective web pages soon and she encouraged everyone to view them. Ms. Krause reported that Sheboygan County has once again received the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting and thanked the Finance Department and Finance Committee for their hard work in achieving this award. Ms. Krause also gave an overview of Ordinance No. 13-Amending Chapters 61, 62, 63, 64 and 65 related to the Airport that was also in the packet and up for enactment and explained these chapters were being updated for consistency and to change the name to the Sheboygan County Memorial International Airport.
