April 14, 2026

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 59.11, the April 14, 2026 session of the Sheboygan County Board was called to order by Chairperson Keith Abler at 6:00 p.m. Chairperson Abler noted that the notice of meeting was posted on April 10, 2026 at 11:00 a.m. in compliance with the open meeting law. COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT
