Allison gave updates covering finalizing the community survey, reconvening an Ebola planning group, an increase in tick bites being reported, and planning for the fall vaccination clinics.

## HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE AND HAZARD VULNERABILITY ANALYSIS DISCUSSION

Steve and Aaron Brault updated the committee on the Sheboygan County Planning assistance on the update to the Sheboygan County Hazard Mitigation Plan. The City has been awarded over 7 million on a mitigation project that requires the completion of the plan by the end of the year.

Steve updated the LEPC on the 2025 EMPG award that has been approved since the lawsuit that was pending last time we met. 2026 funding is also approved but has not yet been released for the grant application. The future of EMPG funding is still a wait and see.
