

**MINUTES OF COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS
PARTISAN PRIMARY ELECTION**

DATE OF CANVASS: August 18, 2026

The Board of Canvass was called to order at 9:00 AM. The meeting was posted on August 13, 2026 @ 8:30 AM in compliance with the open meeting law. The Board Canvassed the results of the August 11, 2026 Partisan Primary Election.

The Canvass was conducted as follows:

County Clerk Dolson reviewed the canvass process with the Board of Canvass. The number of voters and number of ballots cast for each municipality were verified (the highest number was identified and marked prior to the meeting). Some discrepancies were noted. Explanation of discrepancies and resolution follows by municipality. Municipalities that use electronic poll books (Badger Book) are also noted.

Inspector statements were reviewed for signatures and security seal verification.

Candidate totals were verified with original printouts from Election Night.

The following discrepancies were noted:

Town of Greenbush – We broke open Seal #2183692 to retrieve the results tape. Resealed the bag with seal #2083741 with the tape inside.

Town of Herman - No discrepancies. Missing the tabulator serial number on the Inspector statements.

Town of Holland - No discrepancies. Use Badger Books. Missing the tabulator serial numbers on the Inspector statements.

Town of Lima - +300 State Treasurer Republican. Leiber. Missing the tabulator serial numbers on the Inspector statements.

Town of Lyndon - Use Badger Books. Lieutenant Governor Democratic Scattering +2.

Town of Mitchel - Missing the tabulator serial number on the Inspectors statement. Missing the red seal numbers of the purple ballot bags of the Inspectors statement. Representative in Congress District 6, Amanda Bell -2.

Town of Mosel - No discrepancies. Missing the tabulator serial number on the Inspector statement. Missing the red seal numbers of the purple ballot bags on the Inspector statements.

Town of Plymouth - Use Badger Books. The number written on the Inspector statement is not the tabulator number. Looks like it's from the wheeled case more than likely. -1 Sheboygan County Clerk of Circuit Court Democratic scattering.

Town of Rhine - No discrepancies. Use Badger Books.

Town of Russell - Use Badger Books. Leiber -2, Binsfeld -2, Crowley -2.

Town of Scott - No discrepancies. Use Badger Books.

Town of Sheboygan - Use Badger Books. +100 Hong. Missing the red seal numbers of the purple ballot bags on the Inspector statements.

Town of Sheboygan Falls - No discrepancies.

Town of Sherman - No discrepancies. Use Badger Books. Missing the tabulator serial numbers on the Inspector statements.

Town of Wilson - Sheb Co. Clerk of Court Democrat scattering -2. Use Badger Books.

V- Adell - No discrepancies. Missing the tabulator serial numbers on Inspectors Statements. Missing the red seal numbers of the purple ballot bags on the Inspector statements.

V- Cascade - No discrepancies. Missing tabulator serial Number on Inspector statements. Missing the red seal numbers of the purple ballot bags on the Inspector statements.

V- Cedar Grove - Sheboygan county clerk republican scattering +1.

V- Elkhart Lake - No discrepancies. Use of Badger Books.

V- Glenbeulah - Schroeder -100. Godlewski +1 Missing the red seal numbers of the purple ballot bags on the Inspector statements.

V- Howards Grove - No discrepancies. Use of Badger Books.

V- Kohler - Use of Badger Books. Missing tabulator serial numbers on Inspector statements.

V- Oostburg - +10 Binsfeld. Missing tabulator serial numbers on Inspectors statements. The red seal number on Inspector statements was put in the wrong place. Crossed out the number on the results tape and hand wrote another number. Can not do that. No markings should be made on the results tapes. Many spoiled ballots. Missing date / signature from municipal clerk on green chain of custody. 42 in red Julie S.

V- Random Lake - Use Badger Books. The election was "closed." The polls should be closed, but the election should not be "closed" on election night.

V- Waldo - No discrepancies.

C- Plymouth - Use Badger Books. Off by 1, no explanation. 1 more voter than ballot cast.

C - Sheboygan Falls - Use Badger Books. Rep. Assembly Dist #27 -10. Crowley +50. Brennan -51. Kaul +12. No explanation as to why the numbers are off.

General Notes:

- All polling locations should be reconciling the vote count (comparing the number of voters registered in the poll book, to how many ballots have passed through the tabulator) frequently throughout the day and record that in the Inspectors Statement, hourly is recommended. Inspector Statements should never be blank, though some were.

Friendly Reminders:

Chief inspectors are in charge on election day. Municipal clerks should never take on that responsibility, but should be available to answer questions, provide supplies and ballots, and other support as required.

Poll workers should not discourage voters from using the Clear Access machine to vote.

Discard ballots per S.S.7.23. You can discard or destroy unused ballots after the last day for the filing of a petition for a recount for any office on the ballots. There is no need to return unused ballots in the election supply box with the pink label.
