JOURNAL OF THE MEETING OF THE SHEBOYGAN COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

October 19, 2021

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 59.11, the October 19, 2021 session of the Sheboygan County Board was called to order by Chairperson Vern Koch at 6:00 p.m. Chairperson Koch noted that the notice of meeting was posted on October 15, 2021 at 2:45 p.m. in compliance with the open meeting law. The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance by all present.

The roll call was taken and recorded with 24 Supervisors present; 1 Supervisor attended remotely: Supervisor Montemayor; Absent: 1, Supervisor Brauer.

Supervisor Abler moved for approval of the September 21, 2021 Journal, which was distributed to all supervisors prior to the meeting. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Procek and carried on unanimous roll call vote of the board.

COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT

County Administrator Adam Payne stated the 2022 proposed budget was on their desks which will be formally introduced next week followed by a public hearing. Mr. Payne noted that as proposed, there will be a property tax rate decrease of 4%, and a property tax levy increase of 1.14%. The 2022 budget reflects the 6th consecutive year the property tax rate has gone down. Mr. Payne thanked and acknowledged the County Board and Department Heads involved in the budget development process. Mr. Payne also noted that on their desks are the United Way pledge forms for consideration, and that the United Way and all the organizations it supports are so important to the community. Mr. Payne thanked and acknowledged the Bookworm Gardens Board of Directors and staff for their vision and hard work establishing a children's garden adjacent to UW-Sheboygan, and the County Board for its support and long-term lease.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

The Clerk read the report of the Executive Committee regarding Resolution No. 22 (2021/22) Amending Land Records Modernization Plan recommending adoption.

Supervisor Goehring moved to adopt the resolution. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Abler and carried on unanimous roll call vote of the board.

The Clerk read the report of the Executive Committee regarding Resolution No. 23 (2021/22) Authorizing Application for Department of Natural Resources Surface Water Grant recommending amending line #8 by adding: Lake Monitoring and Protection Network Grant and as so amended recommend adoption.

Supervisor Wegner moved to adopt the resolution as amended per the committee report. Supervisor Goehring seconded the motion which carried on unanimous roll call vote of the board.

The Clerk read the report of the Executive Committee regarding Resolution No. 24 (2021/22) Approving Second Amendment to Lease of County Land at University of Wisconsin Green Bay – Sheboygan Campus for Bookworm Gardens Expansion Project recommending adoption.

Resolution No. 2021-72

RESOLUTION Requesting Elimination of Badger Care Eligibility Cliff

TO THE DOOR COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

WHEREAS, in addition to Medicaid, Wisconsin also administers Badger Care Plus a similar program for groups of people who need healthcare coverage but who may not qualify for Medicaid or who need different kinds of services. BadgerCare Plus is also sometimes informally referred to as just Badger Care; and

WHEREAS, those individuals who do qualify for Badger Care or Badger Care Plus face a benefits cliff, defined as, "A benefits cliff occurs, when a public support program is designed in such a way that, at a certain level of income, a small increase in earnings can result in a significant loss ineligibility for benefits." Source; Over the Edge: An Analysis of the Implications of Benefit Cliffs Within Wisconsin Public Benefit Programs, Workshop in Public Affairs, Spring 2020, Robert M. LaFollette School of Public Affairs, University of Wisconsin-Madison); and

WHEREAS, this benefit cliff, in some instances, becomes a barrier for individuals seeking employment, or seeking better employment; and

WHEREAS, allowing individuals to work productively without harming their health benefits, not only reduces the cost of a benefit program but also simultaneously, improves the overall economic activity of a region; and

WHEREAS the drafting of the Resolution has the support of State Representative Joel Kitchens and Door County Health and Human Services Director Joseph Krebsbach.

WHEREAS, this resolution was approved by the Health and Human Services Board on September 13, 2021; and.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Door County Board of Supervisors does herby request, with passage of their resolution, that the Wisconsin State Legislature and Governor Tony Evers work cooperatively to eliminate the aforementioned benefit cliff; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this benefit cliff be eliminated based in a proportionate sliding fee scales that as, individuals and families, earn additional dollars there is a corresponding, but smaller, contribution amount toward their health insurance coverage

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution be included and forward to the Wisconsin Counties Association, 2021 Annual Convention for consideration: and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution be distributed to our local State Representatives, Governor Evers, and other Wisconsin Counties for their local consideration; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that publication of this Resolution may occur through posting in accordance with Section 985.02 of the Wisconsin Statutes.
