MINUTES OF COUNTY BOARD OF CANVASSERS SPRING ELECTION

The Board of Canvass was called to order at 9:10 A.M. The meeting was posted on April 8, 2021 at 8:30 A.M. in compliance with the open meeting law. The Board canvassed the results of the April 6, 2021 Spring Election.

The Canvass was conducted as follows:

County Clerk Dolson reviewed the canvass process with the Board of Canvass.

The number of voters and number of ballots cast were verified (the highest number was identified and marked prior to the meeting). Some discrepancies were noted. Explanation of discrepancies and resolution follows by municipality.

Inspector Statements were reviewed for signatures and security seal verification.

Candidate totals were verified with original printouts from Election Night.

Town of Sherman – No discrepancies were noted.

Town of Wilson - State Superintendent of Public Instruction, +2 scattering.

Village of Adell - No discrepancies were noted.

Village of Cascade - Seal number missing on Inspectors Statement.

Village of Cedar Grove - No discrepancies were noted.

Village of Elkhart Lake - Seal number missing on Inspectors Statement.

Village of Glenbeulah – State Superintendent of Public Instruction, -2 scattering. Court of Appeals Judge District 2, -5 scattering. Undervotes were recorded as scatterings.

Village of Howards Grove – No discrepancies were noted.

Village of Kohler - No discrepancies were noted.

Village of Oostburg – No discrepancies were noted.

Village of Random Lake - Seal number missing on Inspectors Statement.

Village of Waldo – No discrepancies were noted.

City of Plymouth – Pink Defective Absentee Ballots Envelope was not sealed in ballot bag.

City of Sheboygan – Wards 1- 26 - No discrepancies were noted.

City of Sheboygan Falls – Wards 1 -11 - No discrepancies were noted.

Election results were certified by the Board of Canvass. Board members Anita Klein and Anthony Fessler declined per diem.

The Board of Canvass adjourned at 10:30 A.M. This concluded the Canvass of the April 6, 2021 Spring Election.

General Notes:

Inspector Statements should never be blank, though several were. Election inspectors should make it a habit of recording reconciling throughout the day, even when the day is slow.

In order to have a continuous tape from opening of polls to closing of polls the Zero Report should not be torn off. THREE signatures are required at the opening and closing of polls. If three signature lines do not print, the poll was opened incorrectly.

REMINDER: Chief Inspectors are <u>in charge</u> on election day. Municipal clerks should never take on that responsibility, but should be available to answer questions, provide supplies, and support.

Poll workers should not discourage voters from using the Clear Access machine.
