Chairman Abler called the meeting to order at 1:00 PM. Michelle Sifuentes certified compliance with the open meeting law. The meeting notice was posted on February 24, 2026 at 12:00 PM.

There was no correspondence to present to the Committee.

Supervisor Brauer made a motion to approve the minutes of the January 27, 2026 Executive Committee Meeting. Motion seconded by Supervisor Goehring. Motion carried.

The Committee discussed Resolution No. 23 - Resolution Authorizing the Issuance and Establishing Parameters for the Sale of Not to Exceed \$14,800,000 General Obligation Promissory Notes. Baird representative Brad Viegut gave an overview and answered questions. Supervisor Brauer made a motion to approve the resolution. Supervisor Procek seconded the motion. Motion carried.

The Committee discussed proposed amendments to the County Code - Chapter 2. Corporation Counsel Crystal Fieber gave an overview and answered questions. No action was taken.

The Committee reviewed American Rescue Plan Act Subrecipient Annual Progress Reports. Administrator Alayne Krause gave an overview and answered questions. No action was taken.

County Administrator Alayne Krause began her report by sharing that the lease amendment for the Fine Arts and Physical Education buildings at the UW–Green Bay, Sheboygan campus was approved by the Property Committee and will follow the normal approval process through the full County Board. She advised that Deputy Administrator Emily Stewart is currently preparing a grant application to the Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation (WEDC) for the Fine Arts Building. Administrator Krause reported that Lake Breeze Aviation recently celebrated two years of operation and that staff commemorated it with an anniversary event. She also shared that Bookworm Gardens celebrated its 15th year of operation and provided highlights from its Annual Impact Report. Lastly, Administrator Krause provided an overview of the annual National Association of Counties (NACo) Legislative Conference in Washington, D.C., which she attended with Chairman Abler.

Supervisor Goehring requested approval to attend the Governor's bill signing for legislation enhancing county utility aid payments. Supervisor Procek made a motion to approve the request. Supervisor Brauer seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Vouchers were reviewed. Supervisor Brauer made a motion to approve the vouchers. Motion seconded by Supervisor Goehring. Motion carried.

The next Executive Committee meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, March 24, 2026 at 10:00 AM.
