Veterans Service Office 2026 Q2 Update

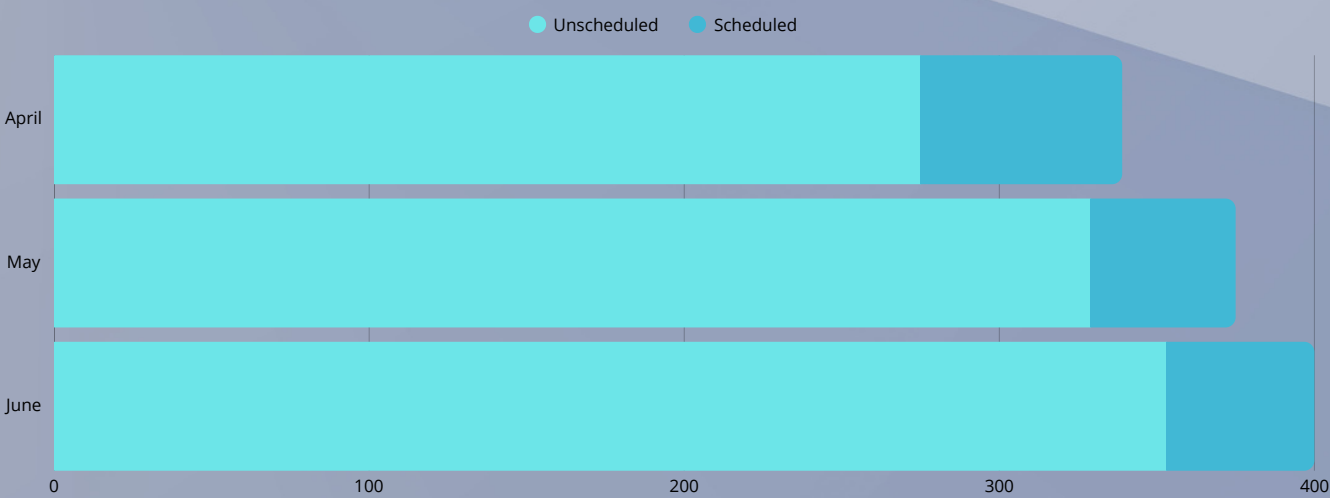


OUTREACH AND COMMUNITY PARTNER ENGAGEMENT

During the second quarter of 2026, the Veterans Service Office continued expanding community outreach and strengthening relationships with veterans, local organizations, and community partners. Staff visited Kettle Moraine Correctional Facility to provide incarcerated veterans with VA benefits assistance and answer questions regarding available services. Outreach also included meeting with students at Sheboygan Christian School to educate them on the mission of the Veterans Service Office and the support available to local veterans and their families, as well as meeting with personnel at US Coast Guard Station Sheboygan to discuss current and future veterans' benefits.

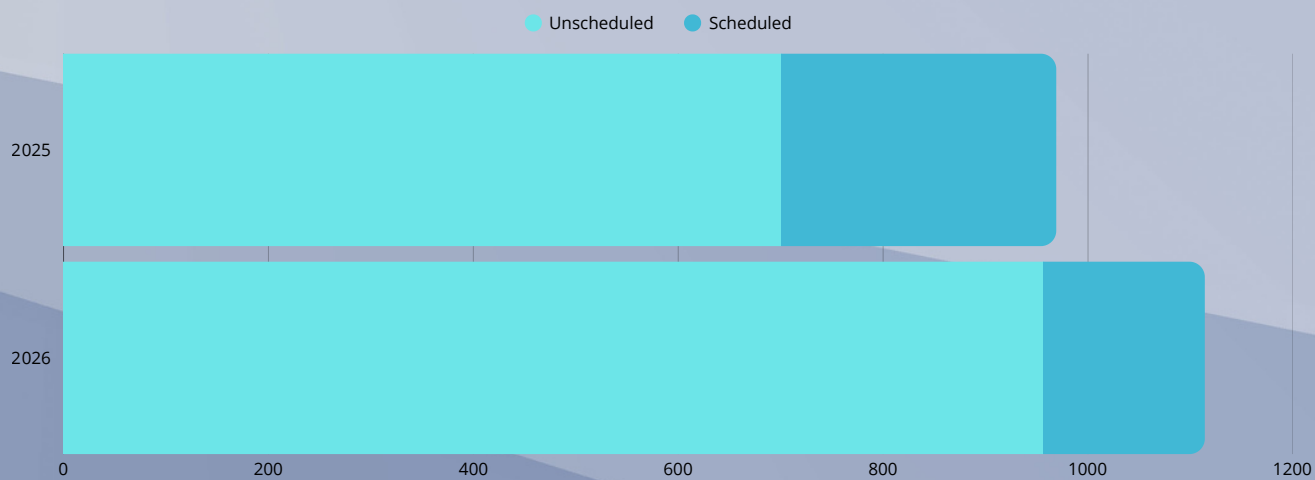
Additional outreach efforts included participating in the Strong Community Connections radio program, attending the Make Your Mark Job Fair at Blue Harbor Resort, and taking part in Memorial Day events throughout the county. Staff participated in the Sheboygan Memorial Day Parade, delivered remarks during the Fountain Park ceremony, attended the Lao, Hmong, and American Veterans Memorial Ceremony, and coordinated the distribution of Memorial Day flags to volunteers who placed flags at veteran gravesites in cemeteries across Sheboygan County. These efforts continue to strengthen community partnerships, increase awareness of available services, and reinforce the office's commitment to serving veterans throughout the county.

SHEBOYGAN AREA VETERANS TREATMENT COURT

The Sheboygan Area Veterans Treatment Court (SAVTC) is a specialized program designed to assist U.S. military veterans who have committed criminal offenses linked to treatable behavioral health issues. Its objectives include reducing recidivism, promoting sobriety, ensuring compliance with treatment, and enhancing the overall well-being of veteran participants.
