Veterans Service Office 2026 Q1 Update



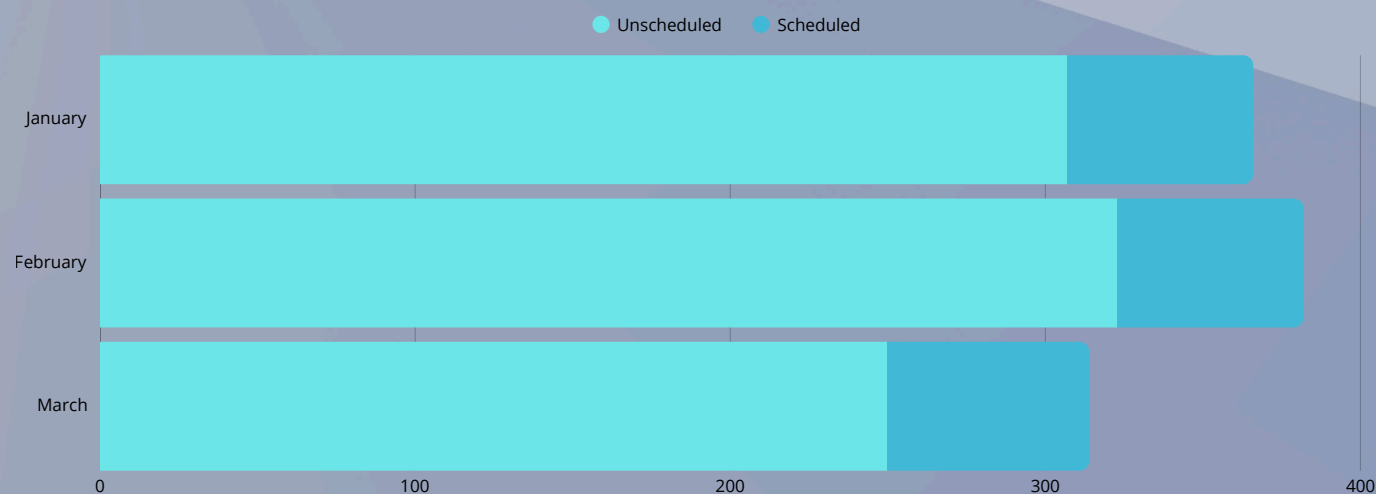
OUTREACH AND COMMUNITY PARTNER ENGAGEMENT

During the first quarter of 2026, the Veterans Service Office maintained consistent community engagement, focusing on strengthening partnerships, increasing awareness of services, and enhancing internal expertise.

Staff participated in monthly Wisconsin Department of Veterans Affairs (WDVA) virtual trainings to remain current on benefits and policy updates. New staff member Brian Verhelst also successfully completed State Accreditation Training, expanding the office's ability to provide accredited representation and direct assistance.

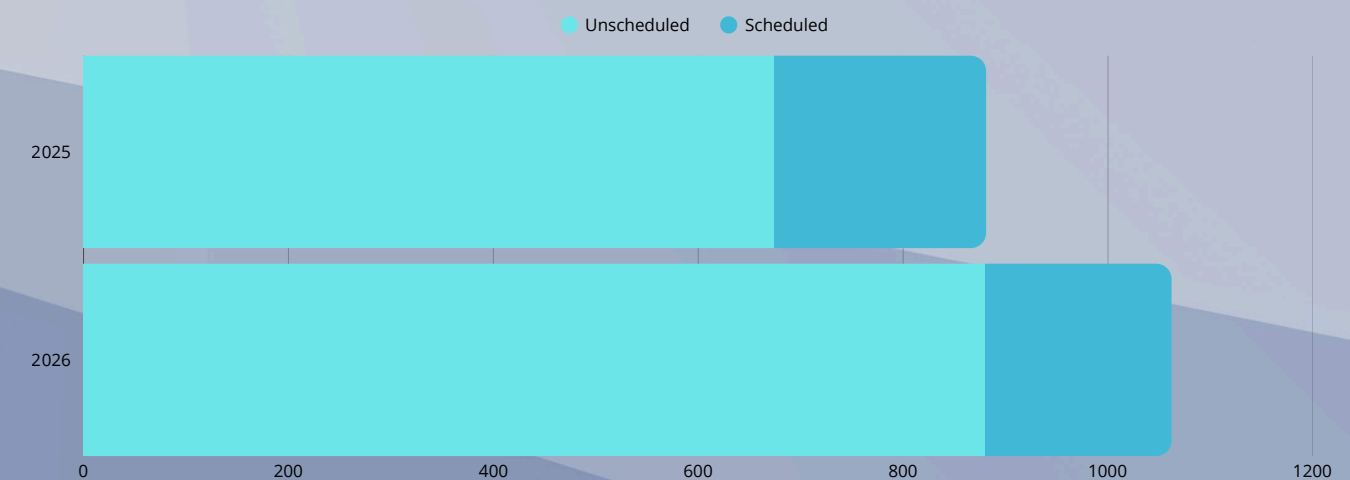
The office continued collaboration with County and community partners, including conducting training for Sheboygan County law enforcement on working with veterans and providing an overview of CVSO services to the Child Support Division to improve coordination and referrals. These efforts support continued visibility within the community and reinforce the office's role as a primary access point for veterans, with services provided through both scheduled appointments and unscheduled visits.

Customer Activity This quarter



- January - 307 unscheduled customers and 59 scheduled appointments
- February - 323 unscheduled customers and 59 scheduled appointments
- March - 250 unscheduled customers and 64 scheduled appointments

SHEBOYGAN AREA VETERANS TREATMENT COURT

The Sheboygan Area Veterans Treatment Court (SAVTC) is a specialized program designed to assist U.S. military veterans who have committed criminal offenses linked to treatable behavioral health issues. Its objectives include reducing recidivism, promoting sobriety, ensuring compliance with treatment, and enhancing the overall well-being of veteran participants.
