Roundtable

A concern was raised regarding STH 23 and the westbound off-ramps to STH 32 due to traffic backups, which lead some drivers to head north, use the first driveway, and execute U-turns. Given that this is a cross-over driveway utilized for farm access, an inquiry was made regarding the feasibility of posting a "No U-Turn" sign. The State noted that they will be resurfacing this area at a later date and are currently exploring the installation of traffic signals at that intersection.
