Scott Shackelford from the Health and Human Services Department informed the Committee members of a grant award to help move toward a trauma-informed community. Scott is scheduling training for this spring regarding trauma awareness. Scott is working with the Domestic Abuse Response Team (DART) and Sexual Assault Response Team (SART) to schedule the training. The target audience includes employees from the courts, law enforcement, District Attorney's Office along with Health and Human Services employees.
